Kent Lilyerd met with the board to discuss issuing a permit to him for him to put a drive in movie theater on his property located by the welding shop. The board informed him that there is a moratorium on conditional use permits until the zoning ordinance is done. He will have to wait until the moratorium is lifted the township is not issuing conditional use permits.

Theresa & Rex Greenwald met with the board to discuss their property located on Imperial & 245th Ave. They would like to make renovations to the house and pole shed on their property to host family gatherings, specifically redecorate and install a septic system. The board informed them they do not need any permits from the township because they are not adding on to the existing house and pole shed. They need to contact the Kanabec County Environmental Services department for the septic system.

Don Kilcher – he owns a cabin by the fishing pier on Co Rd 19 and wanted to know if the board knew where the new boat landing would be if the DNR moved it from its current spot. His concern is if the DNR moves the boat landing next to the fishing pier it would be next to his property line and he does not want that.
