All monthly bills were reviewed. MSC (Ed, Mary) to approve and pay the bills.

Jason Miler, Russ Osterdyk, and Ron Schmidt met with the board to discuss property located at 1950 228th Lane. The Kanabec County Assessor's Office has the home listed as a twin home in their records. The property owners state that the property is listed as a single-family home. The property owners state that the home does have a wall separated two living spaces but there is a door in between that links the two separate spaces together, hence a single-family home. The property owners stated that they will contact the County Assessor's office and find out why the county has it listed as a twin home and report back to the board.
