MSC (Ken, Mary) to approve an agreement with Arthur Township for purchase and storage of salt/sand for the 2023-2024 winter season.

The board discussed the new Minnesota Safe and Sick Time (ESST) law that will go into effect January 1, 2024. The law states that all employers must provide one hour of ESST for every 30 hours worked. This new law does not effect elected officials or appointed officials. Zero land use permit was issued last month.

The board received zero Shoreland permits in the last month.

The board discussed the beaver problem on Legend Street. They believe the problem has been resolved for now but will keep an eye on it.
